

BY-LAW NO. 2012-05
A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BEING A BYLAW TO AMMEND THE ACME CEMETERY BYLAW #1998-09

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part 2, Section 7, Subsection F of the Municipal Government Act, including amendments thereto, a Council may pass a bylaw respecting services provided by or on behalf of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Acme deem it necessary to amend Bylaw #1998-09 by adding the following items.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Acme duly assembled enacts as follows:

Amendments/Additions to Bylaw #1998-09

- (1) Any secondary monument to be placed after the primary monument must be placed flush to grade.
- (2) All burials must be put in designated plots as per the cemetery survey.
- (3) "All monuments/markers must be of granite, marble or bronze. All monuments/markers must be placed within 12 months of internment." See Schedule A for further explanation of costs.

This Bylaw shall take effect upon the date of final passage thereof:
